


PROJECT OVERVIEW

The objective of this project is to improve safety, enhance traffic flow, and reduce crashes to the SR 739 corridor by constructing a continuous raised median, with bi-directional and full median openings, from the Caloosahatchee River to north of SR 78. Improvements also include:

- · Resurfacing of the roadway
- Restriping the roadway to include bicycle lanes in each direction
- Upgrading the traffic signal at Pondella Road
- · Upgrading curb ramps to meet ADA criteria
- · Lighting, signing, and drainage improvements

Additionally, new mid-block pedestrian crossings with special emphasis markings and Pedestrian Hybrid Beacons (PHB) will be constructed south of Pondella Road and at Mariana Avenue.
