The roadway modifications include intersection reconfigurations, the addition of raised medians to the existing two-way leftturn lanes, and a new traffic signal at the intersection of Dr. Martin Luther King Blvd. Additional project elements include addressing any needed structural or drainage deficiencies. All project elements are anticipated to occur within the existing public right-of-way.
