

About the Project

This design project seeks to improve the safety and operations of SR 45 (US 41) in Manatee County. The roadway modifications include intersection reconfigurations and the addition of raised medians to the existing two-way left-turn lanes. The raised medians were strategically placed to reduce the number of conflict points, simplify driver decision making, and to reduce the distances that drivers can travel in the two-way left-turn lanes. Additional project elements include resurfacing near the medians, the addition of new pavement markings, signing and traffic signal loops where necessary. All project elements are anticipated to occur within the existing public right-of-way.


